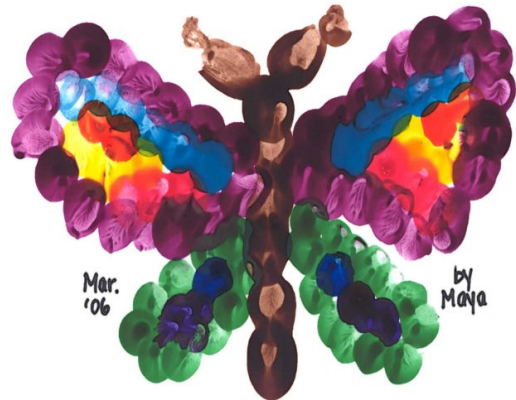
Summer sensory tray

Frozen summer objects sensory

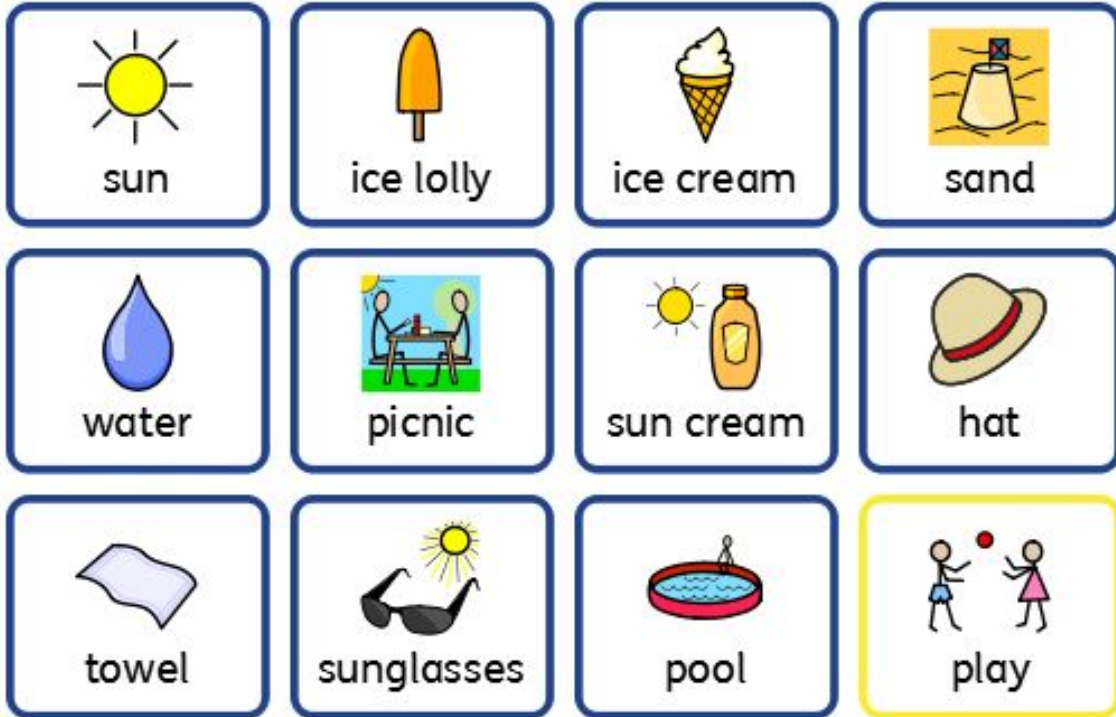
