Activities at the beach

Making sandcastles

Use buckets or moulds to make sandcastles with slightly wet sand. This is one of buttercup class' favourite activities.

Once made can you decorate you sandcastle or smash it down again? If you don't have any sand a recipe we often use at school can be found here

Throwing and catching

Practise your throwing and catching skills with somebody using a ball or a frisbee. If you have a net you could put this up too!

Picnic at the beach

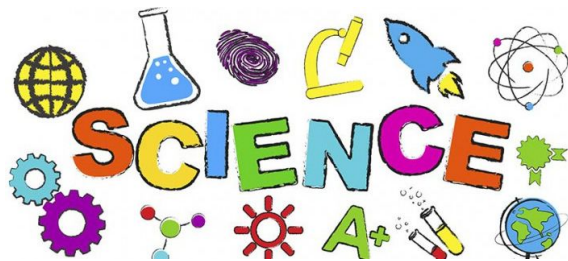
We love having picnics at the beach! Can you help to make sandwiches and chop up fruit to take with you? You could also make drinks for everybody and lay out your picnic area/blanket.
