Activities-

Our topic allows for lots of sensory opportunities to take place, all of these activities are suitable for all of our children. Some ideas include:

Basic Fish Craft that can be used in different ways:

- -First create some basic fish using different textures and simply cut them out (bubble wrap, foil, felt, cloth, washing up sponge/cloths.)
- -If you have a clear bowl or washing up bowl, fill with water and allow the children to drop them in and play with them.
- -Skills that link with this activity: joint interaction, counting, having the opportunity to touch different textures.

Under the Sea Ocean Play:

For this activity you will need:

- Blue Jelly Baff or jelly or water and washing up liquid (Jelly Baff can be purchased via amazon)
- Bowl, bath, small swimming pool or a washing up bucket (dependent on how much you want)
- Sea animals



Shaving Foam Sea Animal Play:

For this activity you will need:

- Blue shaving foam (if you can get it) or standard shaving foam
- Blue food colouring (add to shaving foam if you can't get blue foam)
- Sea animals
- Activity tray



Under the Sea Sensory Bag:

For this activity you will need:

- Medium or large zip sandwich bags
- Blue hair gel
- Small sea animals



Frozen Sea Animals:

For this activity you will need:

- Moulding shapes to fill with water and put in freezer
- Blue food colouring if you wish to change the water blue
- Sea animals
- Squeezy bottles to squeeze water to melt the water and expose the animals





Ocean Playdough:

For this activity you need:

- Playdough (can be shop bought already made or make your own) Recipe to make own: https://www.bbcgoodfood.com/howto/guide/playdough-recipe
- Sean animal and sea shells
