<p><b>Summer 1 Jobs within the Home Routines</b></p> <p><b>School Value</b> <i>Independence</i></p>	<p><b>Home corner</b></p> <p>To engage in symbolic play using dolls and teddies to show familiar daily routines such as:</p> <p>To dress and undress safely and properly.</p> <p>To know how to follow personal hygiene rules and routines.</p> <p>To explore the modelled vocabulary of good, polite personal relationships.</p> <p>To explore and follow rules for safety.</p> <p>To use small world figures to model how to follow school rules and routines.</p> <p>To develop fine and gross motor skills through sorting, construction, and dressing up activities.</p> <p>To develop counting, pattern, shape and spatial skills.</p>	<p><b>Role play</b></p> <p>To begin to role play a short story in a group with other children</p> <p>To begin to role-play a short story using puppets or pictures as visual aids.</p> <p>To use role-play as a stimulus for writing and maths activities.</p> <p>To explore how to use cooking utensils and how to cook simple food.</p> <p>To explore how to find prices on items and how to pay for items in shops.</p> <p>To know the correct clothing to wear for safety and some social situations.</p> <p>To further refine and develop fine and gross motor skills through sorting, construction, and dressing up activities.</p>	<p><b>What needs to be done around the house</b></p> <p>To help an adult perform a daily routine used around the home such as folding laundry</p> <p>To follow a simple instruction (e.g. to push the start button on the vacuum cleaner)</p> <p>To understand that keeping a home clean and safe helps us to stay healthy and safe</p> <p>To know where items are kept in a home</p> <p>To understand the importance of cleaning surfaces for food preparation.</p>	<p><b>Domestic skills</b></p> <p>To help an adult perform a daily routine using an appliance around the home. For example. loading a dishwasher safely or using a microwave)</p> <p>To follow a simple instruction (e.g. to set a timer on a cooker</p> <p>To participate in starting and completing an activity such as helping to sort washing, load and unload machine, sorting coloured from white washing</p> <p>To understand that keeping a home clean and safe helps us to be healthy and safe.</p>	<p><b>Independent living</b></p> <p>To independently follow a variety of recipes.</p> <p>To know how to use a cooker and microwave and the timer on both appliances.</p> <p>To know how to use the washing machine, with selecting the correct wash programme. Sorting washing into the correct loads, white wash, dark wash and coloured wash.</p> <p>To understand how to load the dishwasher and know why dishwasher salt and rinse aid is used.</p> <p>To understand about keeping a kitchen clean and tidy and about cross-contamination, germs and bacteria.</p> <p>To develop and maintain a daily cleaning routine for your home to avoid spreading germs and stay healthy.</p>	<p>Help in School Week Help at Home Week The Great Woodside Bake-Off</p>
