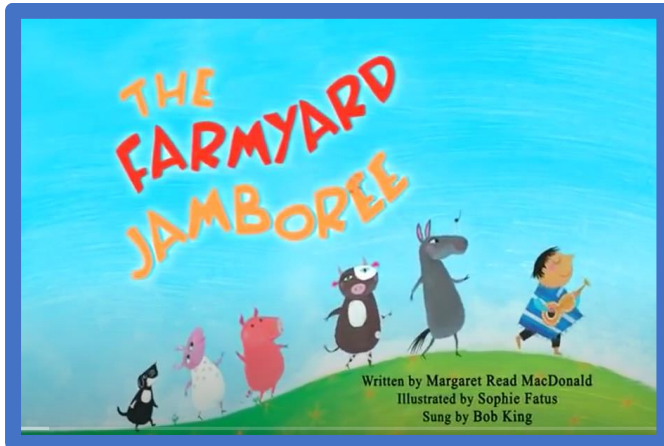


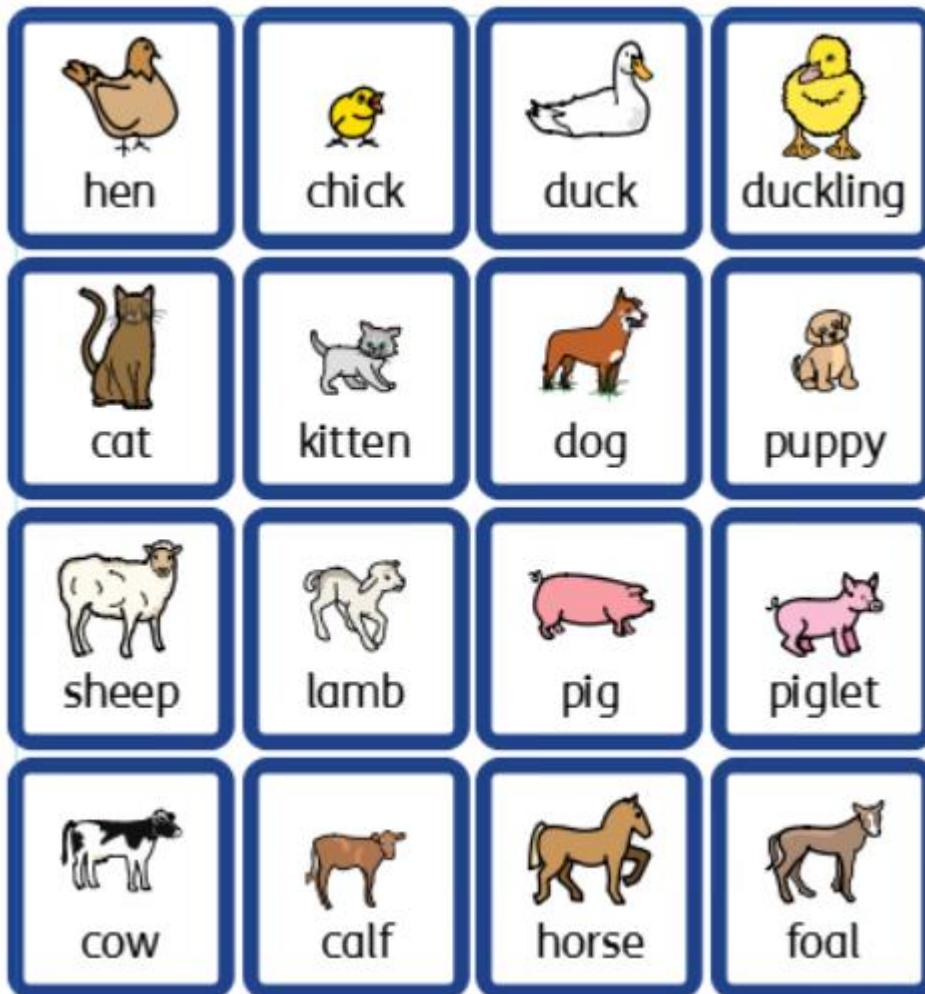
Week beginning - 4th May

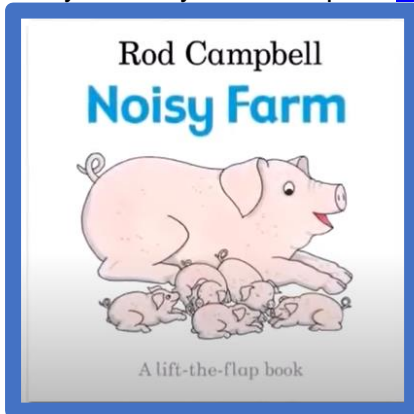

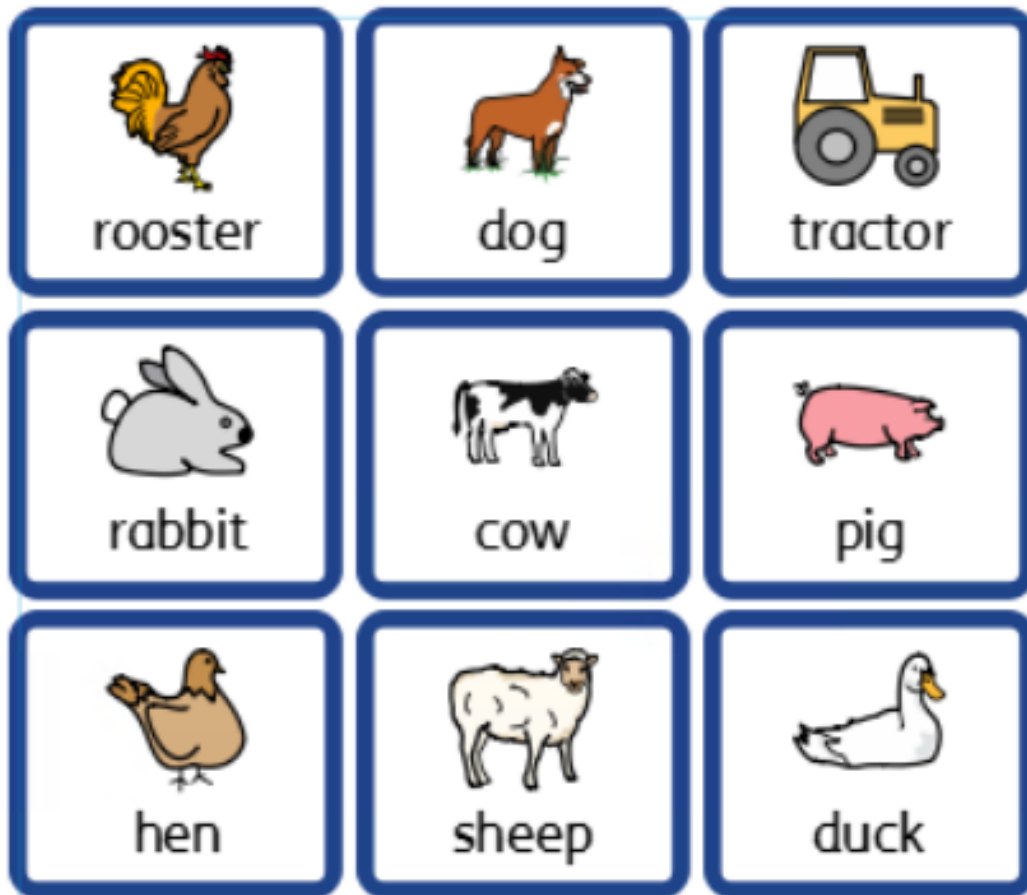

Activity suggestions-

- You may have some animal puzzles at home - interaction through making farm noises.
- You may have some animal books at home. Can they use the picture cards above and find the animals in the story - adult led.
- Tractor / Car mark making - pushing them through soil/paint and then placing onto paper.
- Using vehicles and pushing them through different materials (bubble wrap, fabric, jelly etc) and children experience how this feels.
- Make a barn with different activities - adult led.
- Dirty farm animals to clean in washing up liquid and water.
- Fine motor skills - use cotton wool and a clothes peg. Children are encouraged to get the cotton wool onto the peg and then make marks in paint etc.
- Cooking - using a biscuit recipe, make farm animal shaped biscuits.
- LEGO play - making tractors, farm animals etc.
- Hiding flashcards above in dry sensory trays (rice/flour etc)
- Recap the traditional tale of the three little pigs - you could make some different style houses for the pigs using different materials. The children love to use water, experiment with a water spray bottle and spray the houses.
