Suggestions for activities this week:

- Growing vegetables
- Cleaning 'dirty' vegetables with toothbrushes or cloths (you can use different resources for this mud, cocoa powder, angel delight etc)
- Using vegetables to print pictures with paint
- Making vegetables from playdough
- Tasting different vegetables
- Mark making - colouring pictures of vegetables

- Hide vegetables in different sensory objects (sand, rice, flour etc) and encourage your child to dig and find them
- Encourage your child to pull objects (you could use cars/animals/vegetables, tie string to them and pull them along)






