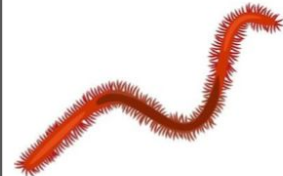
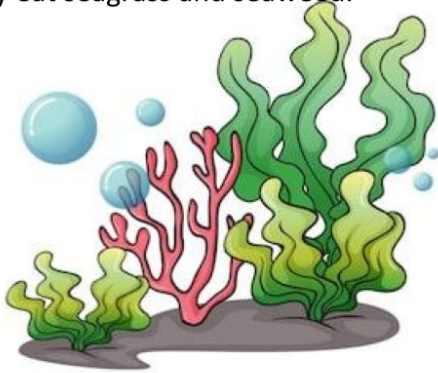

•If they eat rubbish like plastic bags, plastic bottles and crisp packets it can make them very ill and it can also cause them to die.

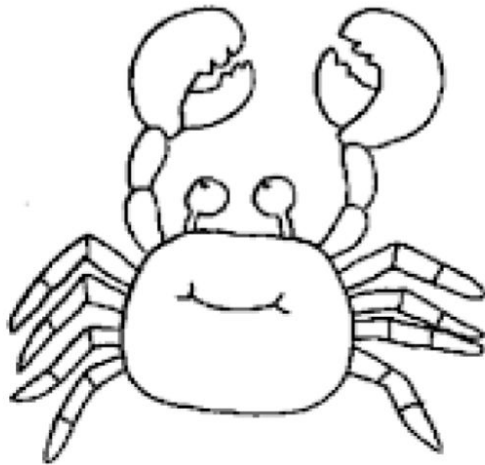
•We can help Sea Turtles and other sea animals by recycling our rubbish and not throwing rubbish on the beach. We must make sure we put our rubbish in a bin.



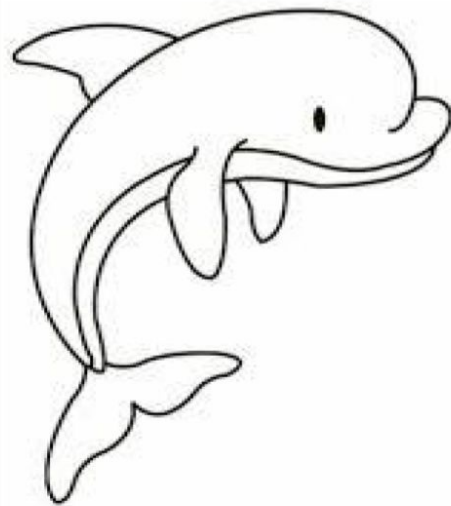
## Make your own Baby Sea Turtle.

- Glue

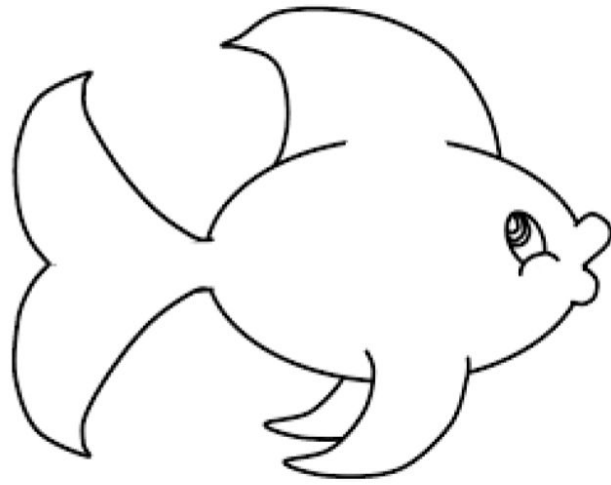
