Dear Parents and Carers,

School reopening update

I am pleased to report that the safe delivery of new pedal bins and some of the hygiene equipment in readiness for reopening. There are a number of outstanding items still to be delivered.

This week, a number of additional staff are completing their 3-day first aid training course so that we increased first-aider capacity. Other groups of staff have attended briefings in school to familiarise themselves with new safety measures which are being set up to promote the safety of everyone. I enclose some snap shots of the training, the new pedal bins and Bramble and also a reconfigured class space.

I am pleased to confirm that Woodside will re-open to a small group of children and young people in Wave 1 on Monday 8th June. Parents and carers of children who have a confirmed place in Wave 1 have been notified separately from this email.

Plans to gradually increase the number of children and young people for Wave 2 will be finalised next week. Please note that for safety measures children may not be returning to their usual class teacher, class space or class team.

Transition packs will be sent home to all returning children to help prepare your child for some of the changes in school and to support a smooth and positive transition back to quite different routines.
